"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £100,000 authorised to be raised by the Waikato County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of making advances to farmers in terms of the Rural Housing Act 1939, the said Waikato County Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal nought five four five five of a penny (.05455d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property comprising the whole of the County of Waikato; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 35 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
