SPECIAL ORDER

Reserves Loan No. 2, 1965, £50,000

THE Auckland Regional Authority in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963, section 37, and in pursuance of the authority conferred upon it under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, doth hereby resolve by special resolution intended to operate as a special order to borrow the sum of £50,000 as a special loan to be known as Reserves Loan No. 2, 1965, £50,000 for the purpose of carrying out development works on various properties acquired out of Reserves Loan No. 1, 1964, £1,000,000. The foregoing special order was made by way of a special resolution passed at a special meeting of the authority held on 17 September 1965. It was publicly notified in the *Auckland Star* on the 24th day of September 1965 and the 8th day of October 1965, and confirmed at the ordinary meeting of the authority held on the 1st day of November 1965.

The common seal of the authority was hereto affixed this 1st day of November 1965.
