"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of eighty thousand pounds (£80,000) authorised to be raised by the Papatoetoe City Council under the above-named Act for the purpose of providing sewerage reticulation within the city, the said Papatoetoe City Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal two eight eight three six pence in the pound (.28836d. in the £) upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the City of Papatoetoe; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day in August of each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of thirty (30) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

THAT pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Papatoetoe City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of seventy thousand pounds (£70,000) authorised to be raised by the Papatoetoe City Council under the above-named Act for the purpose of purchasing and developing land in the St. George Street, Wallace Road, and Cambridge Terrace area, the said Papatoetoe City Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal two seven four nought two pence in the pound (.27402d. in the £) upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the City of Papatoetoe; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
