Exemption Order Under the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964

A motor driver's licence issued under the Motor Drivers Regulations 1964* to the person described in column 1 of the Schedule hereunder may authorise him to drive a heavy trade motor up to a maximum gross laden weight of 6 tons 9 cwt for the cartage only of manure, hay, and farm requisites and in respect of any other heavy trade motor only while unladen in the course of his employment for the employer described in column 2 of the said Schedule, but shall not authorise him while he is under the age of 18 years, to drive a heavy trade motor for any other purpose.
