RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE—RENEWAL LOANS, 1966

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Dunedin City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on the renewal loans detailed in the Schedule hereunder, authorised to be raised by the Dunedin City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of refinancing 4 per cent loans due for repayment during the current financial year, the said Dunedin City Council hereby makes a special rate of 0.2627d. in the pound (£) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the City of Dunedin, comprising the whole of the City of Dunedin; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loans and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the loans, being a period of ten (10) years, or until the loans are fully paid off."

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1953

Change of City of Auckland District Scheme

PUBLIC notice is hereby given that, pursuant to a resolution of the Council made on 6 April 1966, the Council has recommended that the operative district scheme be changed in respect of the matters listed in the Schedule hereto.

The changes of the district scheme as now recommended by the Council, have been deposited in the Town Hall (town planning division), the central library, and each of the branch libraries, namely Avondale, Epsom, Grafton, Grey Lynn, Parnell, Point Chevalier, Remuera, Glen Innes, Tamaki, and Leys Institute, for inspection by all persons interested therein, without fee, at any time when the above places are open to the public.
