Final Prices for Cheese Intended for Export

PURSUANT to the Dairy Production and Marketing Board Act 1961, the New Zealand Dairy Production and Marketing Board has fixed the final prices to be paid for all cheese manufactured from milk or cream delivered to a dairy factory in the season commencing on the 1st day of June 1965, and acquired by the New Zealand Dairy Production and Marketing Board, pursuant to Part II of the said Act, at the several prices and upon the terms, stipulations, and conditions following, that is to say:
