Part Section 12, Block V, and part Sections 5, 10, and 11, Block VI, Otumahana Survey District, Buller County: Area, 770 acres, more or less, as shown on plan numbered 99/19 deposited in the Head Office of the New Zealand Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red (S.O. Plan 9252).
