PURSUANT to section 2 of the Maori Housing Amendment Act 1938, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Proclamation published in the *Gazette* on the 2nd day of December 1965, at page 2113, and registered in the Land Transfer Office at Wellington as No. 655586, be and the same is hereby revoked to the extent of the land described in the First Schedule hereto, and in substitution therefor the State housing land, within the meaning of the Housing Act 1955, described in the Second Schedule hereto, is hereby set apart for the purposes of the Maori Housing Act 1935.
