## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Paihia Water Supply Loan 1966, £55,000*

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Bay of Islands County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £55,000 authorised to be raised by the Bay of Islands County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of constructing a public water supply system for Paihia township and district, the said Bay of Islands County Council hereby makes a special rate of 0.333 of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value (based on the unimproved value) in the County of Bay of Islands; and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 35 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

*Bridges Loan 1966, £5,000*

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Bay of Islands County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £5,000 authorised to be raised by the Bay of Islands County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing the Council's share of the cost of replacing bridges in the County, the said Bay of Islands County Council hereby makes a special rate of one-eighth of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value (based on the unimproved value) in the County of Bay of Islands; and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of five years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Staff Housing Loan 1966, £50,000*

THAT, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Lower Hutt City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of fifty thousand pounds (£50,000) authorised to be raised by the Lower Hutt City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing land and erecting houses thereon or purchasing land and existing houses, the said Lower Hutt City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.249d. in the pound (£) on the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) on all rateable property in the City of Lower Hutt, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be incorporated and added to the consolidated special rate, made pursuant to the provisions of section 108A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, and be payable yearly on or about the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 25 years, or until such time as the loan is paid off."
