Licensing Owen Verdun Wilkins to Occupy a Site for a Wharf and Grids at Helensville in Kaipara Harbour

3. The premium payable by the licensee shall be three pounds (£3) (\$6) and the annual sum so payable by the licensee shall be five pounds (£5) (\$10).
