Closely Populated Locality and Limited Speed Zone Declared

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives notice as follows:

1. That the Warrant, under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962 and regulation 27 of the Traffic Regulations 1956*, dated the 10th day of April 1964†, which relates to Tokoroa, in Matamata County, is hereby revoked.
