Closely Populated Locality and Limited Speed Zones Declared

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives notice as follows:

1. The Warrant, under regulation 27 of the Traffic Regula-tions 1956*, dated the 12th day of June 1958†, which re-lates to No. 2 State Highway (Pokeno-Wellington via Gis-borne) and the Akatarawa Road in Hutt County, is hereby revoked.

2. The area described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a closely populated locality for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

3. The areas described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be limited speed zones, for the purposes of the Traffic Regulations 1956*.
