meeting. (8) In the event of any member of the Council dying, resigning, or vacating his office, the Council may appoint to the vacancy any member of the Society who is available and eligible. Such appointee shall hold office for the balance of the term of his predecessor. Any such appointment shall maintain the proportional or district representation as set out in subclause (2) of this rule. (9) A member of this Council shall vacate his office if he has absented himself from three consecutive meetings of the Council without leave of absence having been granted by the Council.
