- (4) The disconnection and reconnection of telephone apparatus and associated appliances.
- (5) The assembly and repair of telephone apparatus and associated appliances.
- (6) The assembly and repair of automatic telephone and impulse signalling equipment, also the installation of such equipment including wiring of circuits designed for a voltage not exceeding 50 volts.
