So much of the Warrant, under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962 and regulation 27 of the Traffic Regulations 1956*, dated the 11th day of December 1964†, as relates to the limited speed zone restriction on the No. 25 State Highway (Pipiroa-Waihi via Coromandel) at Whitianga, in Coromandel County, is hereby revoked.

2. The roads specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, to the intent that a person driving any motor vehicle thereon at any time during the period commencing with the 20th day of December each year and ending with the 18th day of February in the next ensuing year, and the period commencing with the Tuesday following Easter, shall be subject to the maximum speed limit of 30 miles an hour fixed by the said section.
