(2) That the uses to be carried on on the said land be adequately screened from adjoining residences by fencing or otherwise to the satisfaction of the Devonport Borough.

(3) That the work to be carried out in the proposed garage (as apart from the retail sale of petrol, lubricants, and motor accessories) be limited to lubrication and light repair service only, not to include paint spraying, nor panel-beating nor heavy engineering work.

(4) Leave reserved to all parties "to apply".
