#### *Departure from Operative District Scheme*

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1953

*Approved Change to the City of Wanganui District Scheme*  
PUBLIC notice is hereby given that, in accordance with a decision of the Town and Country Planning Appeal Board, dated the 24th day of December 1964, the zoning of the land described in the Schedule below is hereby changed from industrial "C2" to residential "A".

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### HAMILTON CITY COUNCIL

#### SECURITY RATE

#### *Sewer Loan No. 3, 1966—£400,000*

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Hamilton City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of four hundred thousand pounds (£400,000), authorised to be raised by the Hamilton City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of constructing sewer drains and drainage works, the said Hamilton City Council hereby makes a special rate of four hundred and twelve thousandths of a penny (0.412d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property within the City of Hamilton; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan, and be payable yearly, on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
