A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that a water easement over the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for harbour works from and after the 6th day of March 1967, vesting in the Northland Harbour Board, as from the date hereinbefore mentioned, the full and free right, liberty, licence, and authority in perpetuity to lay, construct, place, reconstruct, inspect, cleanse, repair, renew, and maintain a line or line of pipes under, along, or over the said land, with the right for the Northland Harbour Board's servants, agents, workmen, licensees, and invitees to go, pass, and repass, with or without horses or other animals, or vehicles, over the said land, and to use the said line or lines of pipes for the unimpeded conveyance of water; such easement to be in the nature of an easement in gross.

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 226 of the Public Works Act 1928, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto shall, upon the publication hereof in the *Gazette*, become road and that the said road shall be under the control of the Oroua County Council and shall be maintained by the said Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said council, and that the land described in the Second Schedule hereto shall, upon the publication hereof in the *Gazette*, become road and that the said road shall be under the control of the Kairanga County Council and shall be maintained by the said Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.
