The Land and Income Tax Act 1954: Interest on Income Tax Paid in Advance

PURSUANT to section 207 of the Land and Income Tax Act 1954, as amended by section 89 (c) of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1957, the Minister of Finance has prescribed that interest at 4 percent per annum will be credited on advance payments of income tax made by a taxpayer, being a subsisting company* or a public authority (other than either of them in the capacity of a trustee or agent), or a Maori authority, on account of income tax becoming payable during the financial year ending 31 March 1968, provided the total interest so calculated amounts to 5s. or more. more.

Advance payments carry interest for each complete month commencing from 7 March 1967, or the date of payment (whichever is the later), to 6 February 1968 inclusive.
