### SPECIAL ORDER

THE Auckland Regional Authority, in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963, section 37, and in pursuance of the authority conferred upon it under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, doth hereby resolve, by special resolution, intended to operate as a special order, to borrow the sum of £400,000 as a special loan, to be known as Reserves Loan No. 1, 1964, £1,000,000—2nd Issue, £400,000, for the purpose of acquiring land for regional reserves.

The foregoing special order was made by way of special resolution passed at a special meeting of the Authority held on 13 February 1967. It was publicly notified in the *Auckland Star* on the 24th day of February 1967 and the 10th day of March 1967, and was confirmed at the ordinary meeting of the Authority held on the 20th day of March 1967.
