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TAKAPUNA CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Takapuna Municipal Vehicle Testing Station Loan 1964, £85,000 (£35,000 Portion)

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Takapuna City Council resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on the Takapuna Municipal Vehicle Testing Station Loan 1964, £85,000 (£35,000 portion), authorised to be raised by the Takapuna City Council by way of special loan under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, for the purpose of purchasing and developing land, erecting buildings, and purchasing and installing equipment for a municipal vehicle testing station, the Takapuna City Council makes a special rate of .05d. (decimal nought five pence) in the pound (£) on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value of all rateable property in the City of Takapuna), and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of thirty (30) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

The above resolution was passed at a meeting of the Takapuna City Council held on the 18th day of April 1967.
