

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE COUNTY OF MALVERN

ALL that area, in the Canterbury Land District, containing 1,230,450 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the junction of the middle line of the South Island Main Trunk Railway and the middle of the Selwyn River and proceeding north-westerly up the middle of that river to a point in line with the middle of a road forming the south-eastern boundaries of Rural Section 10806, Lots 6 and 5, D.P. 3012, and passing through Reserves 1763 and 3373; thence south-westerly to and along the middle of that road to the middle of Hororata-Dunsandel Road; thence north-westerly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the middle of a road passing through Reserve 1834 and forming the north-western boundary of Rural Section 37002; thence south-westerly to and along the middle of that road to the middle of Ardlui Road; thence southerly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Reserve 1765; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and its production to the middle of West Boundary Road; thence southerly along the middle of that road to the middle of Rakaia Terrace Road; thence north-westerly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the middle of Steeles Road; thence south-westerly to and along the middle of that road and its production to the middle of the Rakaia River; thence north-westerly up the middle of that river and the middle of the Mathias River to Mathias Pass on the Main Divide; thence north-easterly generally along the Main Divide to the Dampier Range; thence south-easterly generally along the summit of that range through trig. M (Esk Head) to trig. W; thence south-westerly generally along the summit of the Puketeraki Range to trig. S; thence due west along a right line to the middle of the Waimakariri River; thence south-easterly generally down the middle of that river to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Rural Section 9616, Block V, Rolleston Survey District; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the northern boundary of Rural Section 12536; thence easterly along that boundary and its production to the middle of Intake Road; thence south-westerly along the middle of that road to the middle of Halkett Road; thence south-easterly and southerly generally along the middle lines of Halkett Road, Sandy Knolls Road, and Aylesbury and Burnham Road to the middle of the South Island Main Trunk Railway; thence south-westerly along the middle of that railway to the point of commencement.
