RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Staff Housing Loan—£10,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Whangarei County Council did on the 9th day of June 1967, resolve as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £10,000, authorised to be raised by the Whangarei County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for making advances to staff for housing purposes, the said Whangarei County Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal nought four seven pence (0.047d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the County of Whangarei, and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable half yearly on the 1st day of April and the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 30 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

Bridges Reconstruction Loan, £38,000

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £38,000, authorised to be raised by the Whangarei County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for meeting part cost of constructing bridges and reconstructing bridges, the said Whangarei County Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal seven two (0.72) pence in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the County of Whangarei, and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable half yearly on the 1st day of April and the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 30 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

Pensioners Flats Loan 1967—Otangarei Stage II, £24,600

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Sewer Renewal Loan 1967, £16,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Hamilton City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of sixteen thousand pounds (£16,000), authorised to be raised by the Hamilton City Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of repaying on maturity that portion of the Beerescourt Sewer Loan 1953, £101,000 issue of £20,000, which matures on the 1st day of July 1967, the Hamilton City Council hereby makes a special rate of sixteen thousandths of a penny (0.16d.) in the pound on the rateable value of all rateable property in the City of Hamilton, and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April of each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 15 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Waverley Town Council hereby resolves as follows:

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1953

Approved Changes to the City of Wanganui District Scheme
