RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Rangitikei River Control Scheme No. 2 Loan 1965, £93,000— Second Portion £5,000 (\$10,000)

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941, and all other powers and authorities it enabling, the Rangitikei Catchment Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £5,000 (\$10,000), being the second portion of the Rangitikei River Control Scheme No. 2 Loan 1965, £93,000, authorised to be raised by the Rangitikei Catchment Board for the carrying out of the Rangitikei River Control Scheme No. 2, to make and levy a special rate on a graduated scale according to the Rangitikei River Control Scheme classification list of the said area, as follows:
