ORDER

1. This order shall take effect on the 1st day of August 1967.
2. The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby excluded from the County of Whangarei and included in the City of Whangarei.
3. The alteration of the boundaries of the said county and the said city hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Municipal Corporations Act 1954.
