Revoking a Proclamation Declaring an Area in the Otago Acclimatisation District to be a Wildlife Refuge

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Brigadier PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke that part of the proclamation issued on the 11th day of May 1957*, declaring the area of land in the Otago Acclimatisation District, described in the Schedule hereto, to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.

SCHEDULE

THAT portion of the Taieri River and shingle banks between That portion of the Taieri River and shingle banks between a line at right angles to the said river and passing through the northern extremity of the eastern boundary of Section 5, Block XIV, Maniatoto Survey District, and the production of the the eastern boundary of Section 6, Block XV, Maniatoto Survey District, including the road reserves along both banks of the said part of the said river and shingle banks; also Section 26, Block XIV, Maniatoto Survey District, and that portion of Section 6, Block XIV, Iying between a production of the western boundary of Section 26 and the Taieri River. As the same is more particularly shown on plan marked I.A. 52/345 deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon edged red.
