## NORTHLAND HARBOUR BOARD

### RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Northland Harbour Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £115,000, authorised to be raised by the Whangarei Harbour Board under the above-mentioned Act, and in terms of the Whangarei Harbour Board Vesting and Empowering Act 1961, for harbour works and other purposes, the Northland Harbour Board hereby makes a special rate of  $\frac{3}{25}$ ths of a penny in the pound (£) on the rateable value of all rateable property in the Whangarei Harbour District. That the special rate should be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day
