BOROUGH OF GLEN EDEN

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Glen Eden Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of \$200,000, authorised to be raised by the Glen Eden Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of constructing and re-constructing roads and footpaths and upgrading the Borough water supply, the said Glen Eden Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.5555 cents in the \$1 (1½d. in the £1) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Borough of Glen Eden, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

The foregoing resolution was passed at a duly constituted meeting of the Glen Eden Borough Council held on the 12th day of September 1967.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Glen Eden Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of \$40,000, authorised to be raised by the Glen Eden Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for completing the purpose for which the Sewer Reticulation Loan 1961 of £200,000 was sanctioned, the said Glen Eden Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.09375 cents in the \$1 (¼d. in the £1) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Borough of Glen Eden, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 35 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
