Declaring an Area in the Auckland Acclimatisation District to be a Wildlife Refuge

BERNARD FERGUSSON, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare the area in the Schedule hereto to be a wildlife refuge in the Auckland Acclimatisation District, for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.
