Amending Notice Licensing the Tapu Boating Club (Incorporated) to Occupy a Site for a Boat Launching Ramp

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, the Minister of Marine hereby amends the licence published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on 1 October 1964, page 1657, licensing the Tapu Boating Club to occupy part of the foreshore at Tapu Beach as a site for a boat launching ramp, by adding conditions No. 4 and No. 5 as set out below, to the Schedule of conditions:

"4. There shall be payable in respect of all vessels using the said ramp (other than those vessels belonging to financial members of the Tapu Boating Club), a due of 50 cents per day.

"5. There shall be free use and access for payers of dues at all reasonable times."
