PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928 and section 3 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, at the request of the National Roads Board and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby authorises the construction of a further portion of the motorway to be known as the Hamilton Eastern By-pass Motorway, commencing at a point on the No. 1 State Highway approximately 19 chains north of Puketate Road in the City of Hamilton, and proceeding thence in a north-easterly direction generally for a distance of approximately 1½ miles, and thence in a south-easterly and then southerly direction generally for a distance of approximately 5 miles, and terminating at the Hamilton City Boundary near Hungerford Crescent, being the point of commencement of that part of the said motorway authorised by the Order in Council, dated the 10th day of July 1963, and published in *Gazette*, 11 July 1963, Vol. II, page 941.
