Boundaries of the County of Tauranga and City of Tauranga Altered

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of November 1967

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT
IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Local Government Commission Act 1961, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order:

ORDER

1. This order shall take effect on 1 April 1968.
2. The areas described in the First, Second, and Third Schedules hereto are hereby excluded from the district of the County of Tauranga and included in the district of the City of Tauranga.
3. The area described in the Fourth Schedule hereto is hereby excluded from the district of the City of Tauranga and included in the district of the County of Tauranga.
4. The alterations of the boundaries of the said County and the said City hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Municipal Corporations Act 1954.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Tauranga County, containing 760 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the easternmost corner of Allotment 22, Te Papa Parish, situated in Block XIV, Tauranga Survey District, and proceeding north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of that Allotment, to and north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Lots 2 and 1, D.P. S. 1360 and Section 245, Suburbs of Greerton, and that last-named boundary produced to the north-eastern side of Chadwick Road; thence north-westerly along that roadside, to and generally northerly along the generally eastern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. S. 3678, to the southern side of Wylie Road; thence north-easterly along a right line across the last-mentioned road, to and generally northerly along the generally eastern boundary of Allotment 524, Te Papa Parish, to the northernmost corner of Lot 1, D.P. S. 2670, in Block X, Tauranga Survey District, and the last-named boundary produced to the north-eastern side of Faulkner Street; thence north-westerly along that roadside and its production to and generally northerly down the middle of the Kopurererua Stream to a point in line with the southernmost boundary of Lot 64, D.P. S. 2364; thence westerly along a right line to and along the said southernmost boundary, to and northerly along the eastern boundaries of part Lot 2 and Lot 1, D. P. 17807, to and north-westerly
