

boundary of part Section 16, District of Suburban North, comprised in C.T. 2A/331; thence south-easterly along a right line to the northernmost corner of part Section 16, District of Suburban North, shown on D.P. 3360; again south-easterly along the north-eastern boundaries of the said part Section 16 and part Section 16, District of Suburban North, comprised in C.T. 2A/331, to its easternmost corner; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 16, 15, and 14, District of Suburban North, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the north-eastern boundary of Section 12, District of Suburban North; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 12 to its easternmost point; thence generally south-westerly along the north-western boundaries of part Sections 12 and 11, District of Suburban North, comprised in C.T. 1B/669, to the north-eastern side of Dobson Valley Road; thence south-easterly and south-westerly along the north-eastern side and south-eastern end of the said road to the easternmost corner of Section 18, District of Suburban North; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of the said Section 18 to its southernmost point; again south-westerly along a right line to the southernmost corner of Section 8, District of Suburban North; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of the said Section 8 to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of part Section 4, District of Suburban North (3 acres 1 rood .08 perches), as shown on D.P. 1618; thence south-westerly to and along that boundary, the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 5647, and the south-eastern boundary of part Section 4, District of Suburban North, as shown on L.T. Plan 362/C2 to the southernmost corner of the said part Section 4; again south-westerly along a right line to the easternmost corner of Section 1, District of Suburban North; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of the said Section 1 to the southernmost corner of Lot 3, D.P. 3202; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of the said Lot 3 to the eastern side of No. 6 National State Highway; again north-westerly along a right line to the point of commencement.

*The Waipa County Council Lake Control Order 1967*

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT  
IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 8A of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the request of Waipa County Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Waipa County Council Lake Control Order 1967.

(2) This order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. In this order—

“The Act” means the Harbours Act 1950;

“The Council” means the Waipa County Council;

“Minister” means the Minister of Marine; and includes any officer, person, or authority acting by or under the direction or authority of the Minister.

3. There is hereby granted to the Council for a period of 21 years from the commencement of this order, subject to the provisions of section 8A of the Act and to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule to this order the control of the waters specified in the First Schedule to this order.

SCHEDULES

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL the waters of Lake Arapuni the limits of which are described as follows:

“All those parts of the lake edge in or adjacent to Blocks XII, XV, and XVI, Maungatautari Survey District, Blocks XII and XVI, Wharepapa Survey District, and Block XIII, Patetere South Survey District, situated in the Putaruru and Maungaiti Ridings of Matamata County, the Orakau Riding of Waipa County, and the Ngaroma Riding of the Otorohanga County, commencing at a point on the lake edge aforesaid, being the northernmost point of part Section 2, Block XV, aforesaid, and proceeding generally north-easterly, generally south-westerly, generally south-easterly and generally southerly along the edge of Lake Arapuni, the generally south-western face of Arapuni Dam, and again the lake edge, to and generally westerly, generally northerly and generally north-westerly along the generally northern face of Waipapa Dam, situated in Block XVI, Wharepapa Survey District aforesaid, and again along the lake edge aforesaid, to the point of commencement, including all islands therein, and all streams and waterways that flow into the said Lake Arapuni.”

SECOND SCHEDULE

1. Subject to section 8A of the Act, the Council for and within the harbours specified in the First Schedule hereto—

(a) May by bylaw do anything which a Harbour Board may do by bylaw under section 232 of the Act;

(b) May appoint Harbourmasters and or other officers and define or limit their powers or duties;

(c) Shall administer such regulations made pursuant to the Act as are applicable.

2. No authority conferred by this Order in Council shall be exercised by the Council in respect of waters now or hereafter used for hydro-electric installations, except with the approval of the New Zealand Electricity Department.

3. The said rights, powers, and privileges may be at any time resumed by the Governor-General, without payment of any compensation whatever, on giving to the Council six calendar months' notice in writing. Any such notice shall be sufficient if given by the Minister and delivered at or posted to the last known address of the Council in New Zealand.
