Rate of Annual Berryfruit Levy Fixed (Notice No. Ag. 10155)

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Berryfruit Levy Act 1967, the Minister of Agriculture, having regard to the recommendation of the New Zealand Berryfruit Growers' Federation (Incorporated), hereby prescribes the rates of annual levy to be paid by berryfruit growers to the Federation on and from the 1st day of December 1967 to be as follows:

Area of Garden	Amount of Levy \$
Not less than one-sixteenth of an acre but not exceeding half of an acre	6
Exceeding half of an acre but not exceeding 2 acres	15
Exceeding 2 acres but not exceeding 5 acres	25
Exceeding 5 acres but not exceeding 10 acres	35
Exceeding 10 acres but not exceeding 15 acres	45
Exceeding 15 acres	55
