S; thence due west along a right line to the middle of the Waimakariri River; thence south-easterly generally along the middle of that river to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Rural Section 9616, Block V, Rolleston Survey District; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the northern boundary of Rural Section 12536; thence easterly along that boundary and its production to the middle of Intake Road; thence south-westerly along the middle of that road to the middle of Halkett Road; thence south-easterly and southerly generally along the middle of Halkett Road, Sandy Knolls Road, and Aylesbury and Burnham Road to the middle of the South Island Main Trunk Railway; thence south-westerly along the middle of that railway to the point of commencement, excluding therefrom the Darfield Section herein before described.
