1. That pursuant to section 23 of the Counties Act 1956, two of the four existing Ridings be re-named as follows:

- 4. That pursuant to section 36 of the Counties Act 1956, the Coromandel County Council shall consist of nine members who shall be elected as follows:

Representing Coronandel Riding (new name) ... 1 member.
Representing Waiau Riding (new name) ... 1 member.
Representing Colville Riding (new name) ... 1 member.
Representing Whenuakite Riding ... 2 members.
Representing Whitianga Riding (new name) ... 2 members.
Representing Mercury Bay Riding (new name) 2 members.

The alteration hereby made in the number of members of the said Council and the boundaries of the said Ridings shall take effect at the general election of Councillors to be held in the year 1968 except in so far and to such extent as may be necessary for preparing any roll or otherwise providing for that election.
