PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for Maori housing purposes; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 10th day of June 1968.

Suspending the Provisions of the Tramways Act 1908 in Respect of a Tramway at Ferrymead Historic Park, Christchurch, Operated by the Tramway Historical Society (Incorporated)

ARTHUR PORRITT, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 6 of the Tramways Amendment Act 1913, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby suspend the operation of:

(a) the Tramways Act 1908 and all amendments thereof with the exception of the Tramways Amendment Act 1913, and

with the exception of the Tramways Amendment Act 1913, and
(b) the Tram-drivers Regulations 1947, in respect of the tramway situated at Ferrymead Historica Park, Christ-church, operated by the Tramway Historical Society (Incorporated), provided that the Tramway Carriage Regulations 1947 and all amendments thereof shall continue in full force and effect as though the Tramways Act 1908 had not been suspended.
