PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Central Canterbury Electric Power District Order 1965 Amendment No. 2 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Central Canterbury Electric Power District Order 1965* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal order").

2. This order shall come into force on the date of the next general election of the representatives of the constituent districts of the Central Canterbury Electric Power District.

3. Sockburn County Town shall be a separate constituent district of the said electric power district.

4. Hornby County Town shall be a separate constituent district of the said electric power district.

5. The Yaldhurst, Islington, West Melton, Templeton, Prebbleton, Ladbroke, Broadfield, and Tai Tapu ridings of Paparua County and that part of the Halswell Rural riding of the said County which is within the said electric power district shall together be a separate constituent district of the said electric power district.

6. The Central Canterbury Electric Power District Order 1965, Amendment No. 1, published in the *Gazette* on the 29th day of July 1965 at page 1205 is hereby revoked.

7. The principal order is amended by deleting the Second Schedule thereto and substituting the following:

ORDER

(1) This order may be cited as the Christchurch City Council Electric Lines Licence 1959, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch City Council Electric Lines Licence 1959* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal order").

(2) The principal order is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph to the First Schedule thereto:

"7. A line commencing at a point off Scruttons Road and proceeding in a south-easterly direction across the intersection of Martindale and Bridle Path Road to the eastern boundary of the Heathcote County Council's area of supply, as the said line is more particularly shown coloured blue on the plan marked N.Z.E.D. 753 and deposited as aforesaid."
