

BOUNDARIES OF BELFAST RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Waimairi, Canterbury Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the old bed of the south branch of the Waimakariri River in line with the western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 5697, being a point on the boundary of the County of Waimairi as described in *Gazette*, 1953, p. 1991, and proceeding north-easterly along that boundary to the middle of Dickeys Road; thence south-easterly along the middle of that road to and north-easterly generally along the middle of the Main North Road to a point in line with the south-western boundary of R.S. 419; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary and north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of that rural section to the south-western boundary of Reserve 4387; thence south-easterly along that boundary and its production to the middle of the Kaputone Stream; thence easterly and southerly generally along the middle of that stream and westerly along the middle of the Styx River to the boundary of the Harewood Riding hereinbefore described; thence northerly generally along that boundary to the point of commencement.

BOUNDARIES OF STYX RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Waimairi, Canterbury Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the old bed of the south branch of the Waimakariri River in the middle of Dickeys Road, being a point on the boundary of the County of Waimairi as described in *Gazette*, 1953, p. 1991, and proceeding north-easterly generally, southerly and westerly generally along that boundary to the middle of Mairehau Road; thence northerly and westerly generally along the middle of that road to and northerly along the middle of Burwood Road to and westerly along the middle of Prestons Road to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 21, D.P. 19819; thence northerly to and along that boundary and its production to a point in line with the middle of Farquhars Road; thence westerly along a right line aligned on the middle of Farquhars Road to the middle of Grimseys Road; thence northerly along the middle of that road and its production to the boundary of the Belfast Riding hereinbefore described; thence easterly and northerly generally along that boundary to the point of commencement.

BOUNDARIES OF PAPANUI RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Waimairi, Canterbury Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of Prestons Road in line with the western boundary of Lot 21, D.P. 19819, and proceeding westerly along the middle of that road to and southerly along the middle of Grimseys Road to and westerly along the middle of Winters Road to a point in line with the north-western boundary of R.S. 1048; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along the north-western and south-western boundaries of that R.S. to the boundary of the County of Waimairi as described in *Gazette*, 1953, p. 1991; thence north-westerly generally along that boundary to the boundary of the Harewood Riding hereinbefore described; thence north-easterly generally along that boundary to the boundary of the Belfast Riding hereinbefore described; thence easterly generally along that boundary to the boundary of the Styx Riding hereinbefore described; thence southerly generally along that boundary to the point of commencement.

Boundaries of Borough of Queenstown, Borough of Arrowtown, County of Lake, and Arrow and Queenstown Ridings of County of Lake Defined

PURSUANT to section 26 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 and section 16 of the Counties Act 1956, the Secretary for Internal Affairs hereby defines, as set out in the Schedule hereto, the boundaries of the Borough of Queenstown, the Borough of Arrowtown, the County of Lake, and the Arrow and Queenstown Ridings of the County of Lake; the previous boundaries having been altered by Orders in Council made on 7 February 1966, published in *Gazette*, 10 February 1966, No. 7, page 150; and on 26 April 1966, published in *Gazette*, 5 May 1966, No. 25, page 718.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF BOROUGH OF QUEENSTOWN

ALL that area in the Otago Land District containing 1029 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the westernmost corner of Section 20, Block I, Mid Wakatipu Survey District, and proceeding north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Section 20 aforesaid and Section 19, Block XX, Shotover Survey District, to the northernmost corner of Section 19 aforesaid; thence generally south-westerly along the generally south-eastern boundary of Section 19 aforesaid to the westernmost corner of Section 73, Block XX, aforesaid; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of that Section 73 to the southernmost corner of

Section 81, Block XX aforesaid; thence north-easterly to and along the north-western side of Boundary Street to a point in line with the south-eastern side of Queenstown Arrowtown Road; thence north-easterly to and along that side to the northernmost corner of Lot 14, D.P. 7727; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of that lot to the eastern boundary of Section 75, Block XX aforesaid; thence north-easterly, south-easterly, westerly, and southerly along the north-western, north-eastern, southern, and eastern boundaries of that Section 75 to the north-western corner of Section 34, Block XX aforesaid; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of Section 34 aforesaid and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of No. 6 State Highway; thence south-westerly along the middle of that highway to a point in line with the middle of Cecil Road; thence southerly to and along the middle of that road to the northern shore of the Frankton Arm of Lake Wakatipu; thence generally westerly along the northern shore of Lake Wakatipu to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Section 19, Block XX, Shotover Survey District; thence generally north-westerly to and along the generally south-western boundaries of Section 19 aforesaid and Section 20, Block I, Mid Wakatipu Survey District, to the point of commencement.

BOUNDARIES OF BOROUGH OF ARROWTOWN

ALL that area in the Otago Land District containing 330 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at the southernmost corner of Section 64, Block VII, Shotover Survey District, and proceeding north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of that section and Sections 63, 62, and 61, Block VII aforesaid, to the westernmost corner of the said Section 61; thence due west to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Section 7, Block XVIII, Shotover Survey District; thence due north for a distance of 3398 links; thence due east to the right bank of the Arrow River; thence generally south-easterly along the right bank of the Arrow River to a point in line with the south-eastern side of Cornwall Street; thence south-westerly to and along that side to the westernmost corner of Section 67, Block VII, Shotover Survey District; thence south-westerly along a right line to the easternmost corner of Lot 24, D.P. 7702; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of that lot to the southernmost corner of that lot; thence south-westerly along a right line to the easternmost corner of Section 64, Block VII aforesaid; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of that Section 64 to the point of commencement.

BOUNDARIES OF COUNTY OF LAKE

ALL that area in the Otago and Southland Land Districts bounded by a line commencing at the northernmost corner of Martins Bay Survey District and proceeding south-easterly along a right line to Mount Aspiring; thence generally north-easterly along the summit of the Southern Alps to the northernmost corner of Run 97; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of Run 97 to the left bank of the Wilkin River; thence generally south-easterly along the left banks of the Wilkin and Makarora Rivers to the eastern shore of Lake Wanaka; thence generally southerly along the eastern shore of Lake Wanaka and the left bank of the Clutha River to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Block XIV, Lower Wanaka Survey District; thence southerly to and along that boundary and its production to and along the eastern boundary of Block III, Lower Wanaka Survey District, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the northern boundary of Block I, Lower Wanaka Survey District; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of Block I aforesaid to its south-eastern corner; thence southerly along a right line to Trig Station O, Mount Pisa; thence westerly along a right line to the source of the Roaring Meg; thence generally southerly down the middle of the Roaring Meg and its production to the middle of the Kawarau River; thence up the middle of that river to its confluence with the Nevis River; thence generally westerly to and along a leading ridge through Trig Stations I, Mount Mason, O, H, Mount Rosa, L, Mount Edward, and N, Mount Salmond, to the north-western corner of Run 330C; thence generally southerly along the summit of the Remarkables and the Hector Mountains to Lorne Peak; thence South-easterly along the summit of the Hector and Slate Ranges to Trig Station D, Block VII, Nokomai Survey District; thence south-westerly along right lines through Trig Stations G.S., C, and E, Block IV, Nokomai Survey District, to Trig Station ↑, Block III, Nokomai Survey District; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of Section 8, Block III, aforesaid and its production to and along the south-eastern boundaries of Section 22, 6, and 5, Block III aforesaid, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Mataura River; thence generally north-westerly up the middle of the Mataura River to a point in line with the middle of a tributary of the Mataura River, entering the Mataura River a National Grid Reference, square S23,438 301; thence generally north-easterly along the middle of the aforesaid tributary to the source of its right-hand branch; thence north-westerly along a right line bearing approximately 340° to Eyre Peak; thence westerly along a right line to Jane Peak; thence generally north-westerly along a right line to Hummock Peak; thence generally north-westerly along the watershed to Mount Lookup; thence generally north-easterly along a watershed and the summit of the Thompson Range to Round Peaks; thence westerly along right lines through Moffat Peak to Mount Eglington; thence generally north-westerly along the summit
