RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Renewal Loan (No. 1) 1968—\$142,150

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities' Loans Act 1956, and its amendments, and all other powers it in that behalf enabling, the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of one hundred and forty-two thousand one hundred and fifty dollars (\$142,150) to be raised by the Christchurch City Council under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and its amendments for the purpose of repaying on maturity those portions of the Roading Loan 1955, \$1,000,000; Aerodrome Development Loan, 1957 \$800,000; Street Improvements Loan 1957, \$480,000; and Waterworks Supplementary Loan 1953, \$70,000; which mature on 1 July and 4 August 1968, the said Christchurch City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of \$0.0001505 on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property comprised within the City of Christchurch; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate payable on demand during the currency of the said loan."

The Christchurch City Council, at a meeting held on the 17th day of June 1968, passed the above resolution.

SPECIAL ORDER

Altering Number of Councillors

IN exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 53 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, the Upper Hutt City Council resolves by way of special order as follows:

"1. In lieu of eight Councillors the City Council shall consist of 10 Councillors, exclusive of the Mayor.

2. The alteration hereby made in the number of Councillors shall take effect at the general election of Councillors to be held in the month of October 1968, except insofar and to such extent as may be necessary for preparing any roll or otherwise providing for that election."

The foregoing resolution was passed by way of special order at a special meeting of the Upper Hutt City Council held on the 1st day of April 1968. It was publicly notified in the *Leader* on the 17th day of April and the 1st day of May 1968, and confirmed at a special meeting of the Council held on the 6th day of May 1968.
