The licence hereby conferred is subject to compliance by the licence with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1967, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961, the Radio Interference Regulations 1958, and with all regulations made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence.

3. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), and (f) of regulation 15 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1967.

4. This licence shall, unless it is sooner lawfully determined, continue in force until the 5th day of December 1971.

Subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, the Napier City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the licensee") is hereby authorised to lay, construct, put up, place, and use electric lines, and to construct electric works which may from time to time be required for the distribution and supply of electrical energy within the area of supply described in the Schedule hereto.
