### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of June 1968

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 8A and 165 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and, in relation to clause 3 (b) of the Order, on the request of the Waitemata County Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Waitemata County Foreshores and Waters Control Order 1968.

(2) This order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. In this order—

"The Act" means the Harbours Act 1950;

"The Council" means the Waitemata County Council;

"Foreshore" means such parts of the bed, shore, or banks of a tidal water as are covered and uncovered by the flow and ebb of the tide of ordinary spring tides;
