HOROWHENUA ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Electric Reticulation Loan No. 17, 1968—\$400,000

"IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and its amendments, and of all other powers it thereunto enabling, the Horowhenua Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the repayment of the principal, interest, and other charges on the Board's Electric Reticulation Loan No. 17, 1968, of \$400,000, authorised to be raised by the Horowhenua Electric Power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of supplying and distributing electrical energy for the benefit of the Horowhenua Electric Power Board District, and for such purposes to do all or any of such matters and things which the Board is empowered to do by the Electric-Power Boards Act 1925 and its amendments, and by all other powers and authorities it enabling, the Horowhenua Electric Power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.046 cents in the dollar (\$1) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Horowhenua Electric Power Board District, such special rate to be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the said loan and be payable yearly on the 15th day of May in each and every year, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully repaid".
