Decision and Report of Indecent Publications Tribunal

IN the matter of the Indecent Publications Act 1963 and in the matter of a reference to the Tribunal under section 12 (1) of the said Act by the Magistrate's Court at Auckland for a decision and report in terms of the said section in respect of certain books, the titles and particulars of which are set out in the decision and report hereunder:

DECISION AND REPORT

THE books were seized under a search warrant issued under section 25 (1) of the Act, and Waverley Publishing Co. Ltd., of Auckland, was summoned before the Magistrate's Court at Auckland to show cause why the said books should not be destroyed. The question of their indecency having arisen in these proceedings, the Tribunal is required to make a decision and report in terms of section 12 (1) in respect of each of the said books.
