## SPECIAL ORDER

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 23 of the Counties Act 1956, the Waitemata County Council, by special order, hereby resolves that—

(1) The number of ridings in the County of Waitemata shall be reduced to seven (7).

(2) The Helensville, Kumeu, Wainui, and Albany Ridings shall be abolished.

(3) The Whangaparaoa Riding shall be extended up to the boundaries of the Orewa County Town, as may be declared from time to time, and shall include that portion of the Wainui Riding south of the Orewa County Town boundary to the east of State Highway No. 1 and that portion of the Albany Riding to the east of the East Coast Road.

(4) Those areas of the county formerly described as the Helensville Riding, the Kumeu Riding, together with the remaining portions of the former Wainui and Albany Ridings shall be constituted as a new riding, to be named Kaukapakapa Riding.
