S.6845, Lots 5 and 4, D.P. 28257, and part Section 5, Block I, Katikati North Survey District, the south-eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Lot 2, L.T. S.12264, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the southern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 28882; thence easterly along that boundary to the point of commencement, excluding therefrom the City of Tauranga and the Borough of Te Puke as hereinbefore described, and the Borough of Mount Maunganui as described in *Gazette* 1954, page 1266.

BOUNDARIES OF TE PUKE RIDING OF COUNTY OF TAURANGA

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Tauranga County, bounded by a line commencing at the easternmost corner of Lot 40, D.P. S.1538, on the shore of the Bay of Plenty, situated in Block XI, Tauranga Survey District, and proceeding south-easterly along that shore to the western boundary of part Tumu Kaituna No. 1, situated in Block V, Te Tumu Survey District; thence along that boundary, the western boundary of part 1 aforesaid, shown on D.P. 16773, and that last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Kaituna River; thence south-westerly generally up the middle of that river, to and up the middle of Waiari River and the middle of Mangatoti Stream to the north-western boundary of Section 5, Block XVI, Otanewainuku Survey District; thence south-westerly along that boundary to the north-eastern boundary of Section 4, Block XVI aforesaid; thence along that boundary to Mangatoti Road, along a right line to and again along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 4 to Trig. Station 15; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of part Waitaha No. 1 and the eastern boundary of Waoku 2A to its northernmost corner; thence along the north-western boundary of the said 2A to the south-western boundary of Lot 11, D.P. 1042; thence north-westerly along that boundary and the south-western boundaries of part Lot 9, D.P. 1042, part Lot 3, D.P. 32121, and part Lot 1, D.P. 31702, to the southern boundary of Lot 13, D.P. 7603; thence easterly along that boundary and its production to and along the southern boundary of part Section 14s, Ohauiti Settlement, to its south-eastern corner; thence northerly generally along the eastern boundaries of Sections 14s and 10s, Ohauiti Settlement, the eastern and northern boundaries of Lot 2, D.P. S.1502, the eastern boundaries of Lots 3 and 2, D.P. S.11571, and the eastern and north-western boundaries of

part Lot 1, D.P. 9292, to the left bank of the Kaitimako Stream; thence north-westerly generally along that bank to the southern boundary of Lot 5, D.P. 14524, situated in Block XIV, Tauranga Survey District; thence along the production of that boundary to the right bank of the Kaitimako Stream; thence northerly generally along that bank to and along the north-western boundary of part Kaitimako C to Kaitimako Road; thence along a right line to the westernmost corner of a portion of closed road; thence along the north-western boundary of that closed road to and along the south-eastern boundary of Te Onepu Block to the generally western side of a public road; thence south-easterly generally along that roadside to a point in line with the northern boundary of part Lot 1, D.P. 1042; thence to and along that boundary, the northern, eastern and again northern boundaries of part Lot 1, D.P. 14083, and that last-mentioned boundary produced to the eastern side of Waitaha Road; thence northerly along that roadside to a point due west of the easternmost corner of Lot 1, D.P. S.8906; thence due east to that corner, due north to the northern side of Welcome Bay Road and easterly generally along that roadside to a point $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains eastward of the generally eastern side of Ranginui Roadway; thence northerly generally $2\frac{1}{2}$ chains from and parallel to the said generally eastern side to a point in line with the northern boundary of Ranginui 9B, situated in Block XV, Tauranga Survey District; thence to and along that boundary to the shore of the Tauranga Harbour; thence northerly generally along that shore to the north-western boundary of part Ohuki 1c 1, situated in Block XI, Tauranga Survey District; thence north-easterly generally along that boundary to and along the south-eastern boundaries of part Omanu No. 1 to the south-western boundary of Section 9, Block XI aforesaid; thence south-easterly generally along that boundary to Mata-pihi Road, along a right line to the westernmost corner of the land shown on D.P. 26202, along the south-western and south-eastern boundaries of that land, along the last-mentioned boundary produced to the north-eastern side of the Mount Maunganui Branch Railway, and south-easterly along that side to a point in line with the north-western boundary at Papamoa 10A 1; thence to and along that boundary, the north-western boundaries of Papamoa 2 Nos. 10A 2c 1 and 2 and along a right line to and along the north-western boundary of Papamoa 2 No. 10A 2c 4 to the point of commencement, excluding therefrom the Borough of Te Puke, as hereinbefore described.

Boundaries of City of Christchurch and County of Paparua Defined

PURSUANT to section 26 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 and section 16 of the Counties Act 1956, the Secretary for Internal Affairs hereby defines, as set out in the Schedule hereto, the boundaries of the City of Christchurch and the County of Paparua; the previous boundaries having been altered by Orders in Council made on 21 August 1967, published in *Gazette*, 24 August 1967, No. 52, page 1419; and on 25 March 1968, published in *Gazette*, 28 March 1968, No. 17, page 497.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF CITY OF CHRISTCHURCH

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District, containing 26,279 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the low-water mark of the sea (Pegasus Bay) in line with the middle of Beach Road in Block VIII, Christchurch Survey District, and proceeding south-easterly along that low-water mark to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Reserve 244; thence south-easterly along a right line to the northernmost corner of the land contained in C.T. 430/216 being the land described in section 108 of the Reserves and Other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies Empowering Act 1919; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of that land and its production to the mean high-water mark of the sea and along that mean high-water mark to Godley Head; thence south-westerly generally along the mean high-water mark of Lyttelton Harbour to a point due south of Trig. Station MM in Block I, Pigeon Bay Survey District; thence northerly along a right line passing through that trig. station to the southern side of Rural Section 36827; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections 36827, 36826, and 36825 to the Lyttelton and Sumner Road; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern side of that road to Evans Pass; thence south-westerly generally across the Lyttelton and Sumner Road to and along the track passing through Rural Section 205 to the easternmost corner of Rural Section 33906x; thence south-westerly and north-westerly generally along the southern boundary of Rural Section 33906x, the western boundary of Rural Section 500x and the south-western boundary of Rural Section 24077y to a right line bearing $86^{\circ} 11'$ from Mount Pleasant; thence westerly along that line to the western boundary of Lot 11, D.P. 4018; thence northerly along that boundary and the western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 17034, to its westernmost corner; thence westerly along a right line to the north-eastern corner of part Lot 47,
