ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Hawke's Bay Agricultural and Pastoral Society Authorisation Order 1968.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Hawke's Bay Agricultural and Pastoral Society, duly incorporated under the Agricultural and Pastoral Societies Act 1908, is hereby authorised to sell the lands set out in the Schedule hereto, which were derived from the Crown and vested in the Society, in trust, as a reserve for an agricultural and pastoral showground, by Order in Council dated the 5th day of May 1886* (being the land firstly described in the Schedule hereto) and by Order in Council dated the 5th day of August 1955† (being the land secondly described in the Schedule hereto).

Firstly—All that parcel of land containing approximately 7 acres 3 roods, more or less, being Section 20, Block VIII, of the Heretaunga Survey District; the said parcel of land being more particularly defined by Section 20 on Survey Office Plan 1843, and being all the land comprised in interim certificate of title, Volume 87, folio 267 (Hawke's Bay Registry).

Secondly—All that parcel of land containing approximately 3 acres 2 roods 17 perches, more or less, being Section 70, Block VIII, of the Heretaunga Survey District; the said parcel of land being more particularly defined by Section 70 on Survey Office Plan 2824, and being all the land comprised in *Gazette* notice 124084 (Hawke's Bay Registry).
