COROMANDEL COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Coromandel County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing annual charges on a loan of \$15,000 authorised to be raised by the Coromandel County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing improved water supply and sewerage works at Long Bay Domain, the said Coromandel County Council hereby makes a special rate of point nought nine five cents (.095c) in the dollar upon the rateable value of all rateable

property of the Coromandel Riding and the Waiou Riding of the County of Coromandel; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable half-yearly in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 30 years, or until the said loan is fully paid off".
