*Amending a Proclamation Defining Middle Line of the Auckland-Hamilton Motorway in Block XVI, Waitemata Survey District, City of Auckland*

## A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1947, I Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Proclamation dated the 25th day of September 1963, published in *Gazette*, 1963, Vol. 3, p. 1523, and registered as Proclamation No. 20084, North Auckland Land Registry (hereinafter termed "the former Proclamation"), defining the middle line of a portion of the Auckland-Hamilton Motorway in Block XVI, Waitemata Survey District, is hereby so amended that the former Proclamation shall affect not only the land situated within the limits shown coloured red on the plan marked M.O.W. 8508 referred to in the former Proclamation, but also the land referred to in the Schedule hereto within the limits shown coloured red on the plan marked M.O.W. 22498.
