#### ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Wanganui-Rangitikei Electric Power Board Empowering Order 1968.
- 2. The Wanganui-Rangitikei Electric Power Board is hereby authorised to enter into a contract with the Ractihi Borough Council to purchase the electrical undertaking of the Ractihi Borough Council.
- 3. This order shall be subject to the provisions of the Electricity Distribution Commission Act 1967, and shall take effect, subject to the provisions of that Act, and of any final scheme made thereunder, and nothing in this order shall be construed as limiting the powers of the Electricity Distribution Commission.
